


How to contact the police

If you need to contact us, and it's not an emergency then follow these simple steps to make sure you get the help you need:

1 **Want to report a breach of COVID 19 restrictions?**

If you are reporting a breach of restrictions then you can do this via the national reporting form - www.police.uk



2 **AskNED - the non-emergency directory**

Need to ask a question but not sure who to ask for help, then AskNED - dc.police.uk/AskNED



3 **Go online – dc.police.uk**

On our website you can find the answers to many of the questions people ask when calling the police, plus lots of helpful information and advice.



4 **Report Crime Online**

If you need to report a crime or tell us something, then why not report using WebChat or the online Crime Reporting Form. Alternatively, you can email 101@dc.police.uk
